Licensed Plumbers in Western Australia can take pride in their industry as they celebrate the inaugural World Plumbing Day.

In October 2009, the World Plumbing Council launched the annual event with the objective that on World Plumbing Day, communities could appreciate that plumbing has an important role to play in protecting the health of people, and the planet.

“The work of more than 5,200 licensed plumbers in WA makes our lives easier, cleaner and greener,” Manager of the Plumbers Licensing Board, Phil Payne said.

“This day is all about raising awareness of the vital work licensed plumbers undertake in the community.
