Course information is based on the latest industry information, BCA (NCC) and regulatory requirements including: AS/NZS 3500 Series; the Plumbing Code of Australia 2015; Guidelines for Greywater reuse (onsite dispersal of effluent and design), including ATU's; HB 230-2008 Rainwater Tank Design and Installation Handbook and Plumbers Licensing and Plumbing Standards Regulations 2000.

Key topics include:

- Water efficiency
- Energy efficiency
- Waste water reuse and design
- Rainwater harvesting and design

The Enviro West Sustainability in Plumbing training course is open to plumbing contractors, licensed tradespersons and senior apprentices currently working in the building and construction industry. Upon successful completion of the training program, course graduates will receive a Certificate of Completion and will also be accredited on the Master Plumbers and Gasfitters Association of WA's Enviro West website (if a member at time of course completion).
